ATV Trails

Arco Pass/Wood Canyon Loop

Beautiful desert scenery, geological formations, canyons creeks and breathtaking wildflowers abound during the early spring months. Highly recommended for rock hounds, it also has several old mining sites. This loop has a variety of wildlife: coyote, deer, badger, antelope and birds. While this ride is considered “laid back” for most ORV riders, it is not recommended for novice operators. The entire loop is just short of 60 miles and is easily a full day of recreation.

The Arco Pass/Wood Canyon Loop trail can be accessed from the Arco City Park where you will find an ATV unloading area and plenty of parking with restrooms. The trail is well marked for your enjoyment.

BE A RESPONSIBLE RIDER - Travel only in areas open to ATV and Motorcycle use—Stay on designated routes—Respect private land—Leave gates as you find them—Avoid riding in meadows and marshy areas—Avoid riding on steep or erodable slopes—Be courteous while passing others on the trail.

SAFETY TIPS - Obtain a map of the trail area—Tell someone of your travel plans—Don't ride alone—Check the weather forecast—Bring extra food and water—Bring a first aid kit—Make sure your machine is mechanically sound before your ride—Know your limitations—Never mix riding with alcohol or drugs.
