You may also want to test your fortitude at the annual Chili Cook-off on Saturday. Cooking starts at 10:00 AM and should be ready for tasting by 2:00 PM.

If you like Mountain Bike Racing, the White Knob Challenge will prove to be a wild ride. Racers take off from Main Street on a 9-mile ascent that features 2,300 feet in elevation gain, followed by a rip-roaring roller coaster descent to the valley floor. Start time is High Noon on Saturday.

Take a minute to look up and watch the Treasure Valley Soaring organization pilot their graceful gliders across the skies of Mackay all weekend.

Have you been to a small town fair lately. Wander down to the fair grounds and support our local youth as they compete with their fellow 4-H members in a round robin for best in showmanship. Each competitor is required to show a market animal in every category. The categories are sheep, swine, steer and horse. Judging starts at 1:00 PM sharp. New this year—The Mackay Dirt Devils will compete for best in showmanship with their ATV or Dirt Bike. Judging starts at 9:00 AM.
